COVID - 19 GUIDELINES

The Covid-19 Facility Plan has been designed to allow for maximum social/physical distancing while attending training sessions at Portland Sports Complex, Seacoast United and Saint Joseph's College. Foot traffic will flow in one-way patterns as much as possible. Fields will have separate check-in areas in an effort to keep players in small groups and assist with contact tracing if necessary. While waiting for training sessions to begin, or for family to pick up, players are asked to follow social distancing guidelines within the designated areas. Playing areas/field surfaces are designated for coaches and players only.









- Distribute & post Return to Play protocols
- Be sensitive and accommodating to parents who may be uncomfortable on returning to play
- Train & educate staff on return to play protocols
- Provide all coaches with all player contact information
- Provide adequate field space to accommodate social distancing
- Ensure appropriate bathrooms at facility
- Designate staff members to run health screening prior to session
- Track all players screening results
- Set training schedule to maximize social distancing
- Set facility entrance/exit pathways for each field

- The designated Entrance will be closest to The Edge Academy (near the MSFH Office)
- The designated Exit will be off the small field at the bay door.
- Second group is not allowed to enter until waved in by a coach.
- Players will check in each session. Answer questions, take temperature and all information will be documented

- Parents and spectators are asked to respect and adhere to social/physical distancing guidelines. Please do not approach the playing area. Stay in cars during drop off & pick up.
- The designated Entrance will be the rotating door for the Big Field and the front door for Roller World
- The designated Exit will be the rotating door for the Big Field and the front door for Roller World.
- Second group is not allowed to enter until waived in by a coach,
- Players will check in each session. Answer questions, take temperature and all information will be documented

- Follow all return to play protocols
- Parents and spectators are asked to respect and adhere to social/physical distancing guidelines. Please do not approach the playing area. Stay in cars during drop off & pick up.
- The designated Entrance will be closest to the parking lot (nearest the scoreboard)
- The designated Exit will be at the opposite end of the field (nearest the road).
